Google is gradually releasing versions of the Chromebook software (Chrome OS) that supports the Google Play store. If you aren't sure your device supports Google Play, Google provides a growing list of devices that support it. If you are still uncertain, make sure your Chromebook has Chrome OS version 53 or higher. To make sure your Chromebook is up to date and can run Google Play, check the current version. Here's how. In the lower-right corner of the screen, select the taskbar (where the time displays). Select Settings (which looks like a gear). Select About Chrome OS. Select Advanced if you don't see this option. The version of Chrome OS appears on the right side. After you've confirmed you have the correct version, open the Play Store. (If you recently updated, you should have seen this install.) If you don't have version 53 or higher, select Check For Updates to see if there's an update for your Chromebook. Now it's time to find some apps to install. Select the Start button (which looks like a white circle). Either enter Play Store in the search menu or select the up button to display more apps. Select the Play Store icon. Now you're ready to find fun and productive apps. At the top of the screen, select the box that says Google Play. This is the search box you'll use to find apps. Enter your search criteria and press the Enter key. For example, if you need a calendar app, enter calendar. The search results appear. Select each result to read a summary of the app, see some screenshots, and read reviews of the app. Some apps are not free or have in-app purchases to enable certain features. When you decide on an appropriate app, select Install. The view shows the app is downloading and has a progress bar to show its installation progress. Once the app is installed, the app information screen displays an Open button instead of Install. Alternatively, go to the apps list and click the icon. You now have a new app to play with. The Google Web Store is what Chrome OS systems used before Google implemented access and usage of the Google Play store. While many apps are listed in both places, the Web Store may not have the selection the Play Store has. Select the Start button (it looks like a white circle). If Web Store doesn't appear in the Frequent Apps list, select the Up arrow to see all apps. Select the Web Store icon. A Chrome web page appears. Select the Apps heading. From here, in the upper-left corner under the Chrome Web Store logo, enter your search criteria for the app you want. After you enter your search criteria, press Enter. Just like on the Play Store, selecting a listing provides additional information on the selected app. After you decide which app you want to install, select Add to Chrome in the app details window. Alternatively, select Add to Chrome in the app search results window. After you select the Add to Chrome button, a dialog box appears and asks if you want to install the app. If so, select Add extension. Once the installation has completed, another dialog box appears notifying you of the completion. In the app search list, you'll find a green button to Rate It and a small green banner on the app stating Added. Or, in the app details view, it says Added to Chrome. It's a great app for discovering new music, as it features radio stations from all over the world. Aside from music tracks, you can also use it to listen to and download podcasts. You can start listening to and recording the songs as soon as you download and install the app. One of the most useful features of the app is the ability to schedule your downloads. Before you install it, you have to make sure your phone is compatible with it and able to receive the latest update, which we can help you with. If your device is over 2 years old, has already received two major Android OS updates, or is a lower-end budget device, you might not be seeing Android 10 at all. We've collected rumors for each of the manufacturers in our Android 10 updates post, so you can check there for the latest news on a variety of devices. However, there are some devices which are a given. All of Google's Pixel phones have already received the update, while the latest flagship phones — like the Samsung Galaxy Note 10 range and Huawei's P30 range — are also highly likely to get the update. You can also safely assume any phone that took part in the Android 10 beta is likely to receive the update. The Android 10 beta program was the largest in Android's history, with an amazing 25 devices from 13 manufacturers taking part. Make sure to back up your Android phone to your PC to make sure your precious data is as safe as houses. How to install Android 10 So your phone has been confirmed to be getting the Android 10 update — hurrah! Now what? Well, you may have to wait a while. Some manufacturers take a little while to push the update out, whether it's the speedier companies like Nokia, or the slowpokes of Samsung and LG. That usually comes down to how much work they have to do, and creating manufacturer UIs like Samsung's upcoming One UI 2.0 can take a significant amount of time. Thankfully, when your update is ready, it'll be pushed through to your phone and you'll be prompted to upgrade. You can either upgrade right then and there, or you can choose to have your phone install it at a later time when it's more convenient — you can even have it update overnight. If you're really, really excited about it (like us) then you can manually check to see if the update has come in. To do so, head to Settings > System > Advanced > System update > Check for update. If you're not using a stock Android phone, then your path to finding the updates section may be slightly different — for instance on Samsung phones, you can access Software update directly from the Settings app — but its almost always somewhere in your Settings.
